

Tee Time Policy

Weekend and holiday tee times must be requested in writing to the pro shop by the close of business each Tuesday. Tee times are drawn IAW established policy early every Wednesday morning prior to the weekend or holiday. All interested parties are invited to witness the drawing. Weekday tee time requests may be made by phone or in person by active duty personnel three days in advance and by all other eligible patrons two days in advance.

Priorities:

1. The first priority for weekend and holiday tee times is to any two, active duty or active duty dependents in one group. Second priority is to any two, retired military or reservists in one group. Third priority is for all other eligible patrons.
 2. Weekend and holiday tee times assigned to active duty (priority) personnel and their dependents will be honored when two active duty personnel/dependents, listed on the "Request for Tee Time" sheet are present.
 3. Weekend and holiday tee times assigned to retired military personnel will be honored when two retired military personnel or reservists listed on the "Request for Tee Time" sheet are present.
 4. Tee times cannot be given away to others and duplicate written requests will be discarded. A waiting list will be used for all unused tee times and will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. All players must check in with the starter for safety purposes (in case there are emergency notifications, etc.). Participants, who are not annual green fee members, will purchase a daily green fee ticket prior to reporting to the starter.
- The course marshals are specifically charged with ensuring all groups maintain the pace of play. Please refer to the "Pace of Play" brochure for more information.
